A few color variations offered by Keene

Color varies

We can make products in multiple colors. We have made greens, blues, reds, and pinks along with black (which is produced with recycled material).

Thickness varies

Keene has made products from a single filament of about 1-millimeter to 5-inches in thickness. We've made one-side thick and the other side thin. We can slope a design so that items placed on it have an angle.

Width varies

Keene's width capabilities range from 3-inches to 8-feet wide.

Geometry varies

Keene's entangled net geometries are limited only to our customers imaginations. Custom molded shapes coupled with Keene's die cutting capabilities allow for almost limitless shapes and sizes.

Filament size varies

We can make products with various filament diameters to change the texture and feel of a product.

Lamination capabilities

We can laminate to foils, paper, fabrics and membranes, as well as laminate material on one-side only or on both sides.

The possibilities are endless.
